Purpose, processing activities, personal data, legal basis, and retention period

<p>Legal basis: The legal basis for our processing of your personal data for the stated purposes is your consent, and you can at any time withdraw your consent by unsubscribing by using the link provided in the information or by contacting us. We will also annually send you a reminder and give you the opportunity to unsubscribe if you do not want to receive the information from us.</p>		
<p>Retention period: The personal data is stored for as long as we provide the information, and we assess that the information is relevant for you, or until you withdraw your consent, after which the personal data will be deleted.</p>		

How we collect your personal data

We collect personal data in two ways

- 1) When you provide us your personal data, e.g. sign up to the newsletter or other request made by you
- 2) By complementing information provided by you with information from other sources, such as publicly available personal address registers, search through publicly available search engines, sector-specific newsletters, social media, and your employer's website.

Recipients of the personal data and processors

We may instruct another party to perform such processing as specified above, for example a subsidiary or when employing suppliers of IT-services or suppliers of marketing services. Where personal data is processed on our behalf, the data processor must implement the appropriate security measures and only process the personal data according to our instructions and for the specified purposes. Some partners and suppliers may have part of their activities in non-EU/EEA countries. Any transfer to such countries is done in accordance with applicable data protection laws and only to countries that provide adequate level of protection according to the Commission of the EU or that the supplier or partner has provided appropriate safeguards and on condition that enforceable data subject rights and effective legal remedies for data subjects are available.

Your rights

You have the right to:

- withdraw your consent as mentioned above,
- request information about our processing of your personal data (right of access);
- request rectification of inaccurate or incomplete personal data concerning you

- request erasure of the personal data concerning you
- request restriction of the processing of your personal data
- request to receive the personal data which you have provided to us
- object to our processing of your personal data
- to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority

Certain limitations may apply to the different rights following the personal data legislation.

Please note that any limitation or deletion of your personal data may mean that we will not be able to provide you the services described above.
